This notebook contains a broad variety of information about Auburn, Osceola and Eden Townships. Some of the entries are mere mention of a name, while others give a few helpful details. In many instances, the legal description of property is given. There are no long, detailed entries. Pages 55-70 are blank.

R-107 is a large spiral-bound notebook of Mr. Reese's field notes. The pages are numbered, with the exception of the first 5 sheets and the inside of the front cover, on which he also has notes. We have therefore numbered these first pages separately, prefixing the number with the letter A. Thus, the inside of the front cover is A-1, the front of the next sheet is A-2, and so on. Some of these front pages are blank.

The cover of the notebook is a deep red; the writing on the inside front cover is therefore hard to read.

About half of the cover is torn loose from the spiral. We ask patrons to handle this notebook gently, so that it will be in reasonable condition for patrons many years from now.

We caution patrons to use a *variety of spellings* when searching for a particular person. In general, we have copied a given spelling as Mr. Reese wrote it, unless we are certain that he had spelled it wrong. Since *there was no set spelling for many proper names until around 1900*, it is not unusual to find names spelled in a variety of ways.

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
