*Town of Eden, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, Sec. 22, located on Co. Hwy F, about ¼ mile East of Co. Hwy. V. This cemetery is partially kept up. There is a large amount of brush at one end, and it is not known if there are more grave sites in/under this. Cemetery deeded March 8, 1858.*
