HISTORY OF THE CAMPBELLSPORT LIONS CLUB, 1931-1976

This folder consisted of two pages of hand-written notes (Mr. Reese's writing), a number of pages of more hand-written notes (not Mr. Reese's writing), and a typed version of the preceding. The latter appears to have been typed by Jeanne Marchant. It is unclear if she also did some of the research.

The Campbellsport Lions Club was organized in March of 1931 and the first meeting for election of officers was in July. And Dr. Uelmen was elected President and Charles Van De Zande was elected Secretary and Treasurer.

Promotional activities over a period of years:

- October 1931 - Fall Festival on Main Street
- Established milk tickets and clothing for the needy
- Conducted Christmas seal campaign
- Constructed skating rink for the children

Promotional activities for construction of sewer and water which was done in 1935-6:

- Sponsored Campbellsport baseball team
- Sponsored the Campbellsport band concerts
- Sponsored the Halloween Parade for children - 1932
- Sponsored Santa Claus Day - Dec. 1934
- Started decorating the light poles - Dec. 1934
- The Roosevelt birthday ball in 1933-34-35
- High School athletic recognition and party - 1939
- Provided free movies in village on Saturday nights - 1934
- Reorganized the Boy Scout troop in 1935 and Charles Glass was first scout master with the interest of Lion and Finemen
- C. J. Kleinhans the Finemen completed the Boy Scout cabin in 1952
- The Harmers Institute was conducted by Lyle [sic] Viney and John Collier in 1936 and was done many years after for community relations
- Established tennis court in 1938
- Good Friday afternoon business closing 1938
- In May of 1938 sponsored civic banquet for Dr. P.A. Hoffman for fifty years of community service
