This particular folder contained an exceptional amount of repetition. We have copied it as written, unless the notes matched the typewritten materials verbatim. Community Surgeons

Dr. Rudolph Zimmerman-1858 to 1902.

He came from Germany in 1858 and made his home and office at 218 South Jenny Street. His second office was at 418 East Main was the first physician and Surgeon in New Cassel.

Dr Louis Eidemiller- Dec. 28,1875 to 1927.

He was our second physician and surgeon in New Cassel. His office and home was On 340 East Main Street.

Dr. Seth Pickett- 1863.

He was the first physician in the Town of Ashford. On March 20, 1863, he started his practice. He was the first town clerk of Ashford and established its name through state legislature.

Dr. William Hausman-1874.

His practice was located in Elmore, started on March 10, 1874. His office and home was block 1, lots 3 & 4 of Leglers addition. It was purchased October first, 1877.

Dr. Clement Marsden- 1850, February 16, 1882.

The doctor came from New Hampshire in 1850. His office and home was at 250 North Fond du Lac Ave.

Dr. Stephen Stack- 1874 to 1878.

His office was in the old Mathias Schlaefer building at 128 West Main Street.

Community Physicians

Dr. Peter A. Hoffman- 1888 to 1930.

He first practiced from the Mathias Schlaefer building and later built his office and home at 129 North Fond du Lac Ave.

Dr. E.J.Orvis- 1888 to 1896.

He first had his office above the Durand and Paas Drug Store, and later built the office and home at 229 North Fond du Lac Ave.

Dr. Frank Russel- 1902 to 1906.

Built his office and home at 267 East Main St.

Dr. Johnstone H. Weld- 1901 to 1904, and 1908 to 1927.

Purchased the practice of Dr. Orvis in October of 1896. He built his office and home at 203 East Main St., sometime in 1909. His office was in the Platt Durand Drug Store form 1901 to 1909 before he built his home.

Dr. Mathias Hoffmann- 1903 to 1913.

A son of Dr. Peter Hoffmann, he practiced from his dad's office till he was killed in an auto-train accident.

Dr. Leo Hoffmann- 1919 to June 1981.

He is still active. Practiced from his dad's office on 129 North Fond du Lac Ave.

Dr. Walters- 1914 to 1917.

Practiced from James and Michael McCullough store building. Location was 105 East Main Street.

Dr. E.M. Kensten- 1914.

He practiced in the bank building.

Dr.A.E.Sturm- April 1, 1915.

He was located at the Joseph Bauer Hotel at 139 south Fond du Lac Ave.

Dr. O.F. Guenther- July 8, 1926 to Sept. 15, 1958.

He was located at 133 South Fond du Lac Ave.

Dr. Richard Graves- Aug. 13, 1959 to 1965.

He practiced in the Pesch building at 130 North Fond du Lac Ave.
