The burials for Rauch Cemetery are listed in "*Cemeteries in Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin*". (www.rootsweb.com/~wifonddu/resources/cemindex2.htm). The researcher is encouraged to examine that record. It may be especially helpful because it includes a number of obituaries. However, *we also include here the record as given in R-29*, as there are a few differences. It should be kept in mind that the cemetery is very old and is no longer used; therefore, the headstones may be difficult to decipher.

The following is copied as found in R-29. The comments by Halbur are entered in brackets, and in italics.

Section 36, Ashford Township, intersection of Lake Berniece Drive and Badger Drive. The land was sold Dec. 19, 1954 by Frederick and Wilhelmina Rauch to the Evangelist Church.

Baum, William 1867-1909
Baum, Hattie 1868-1950
Haessly, Christina 1864-1927

Rauch, four small stones of concrete – not readable. One [or] two the names Friederick and Wilhelmina were vaguely discernible.

Rauch, Bertha 1859 – 19—his wife

Rauch, Henry No dates but stone around edge of grave

Series of large stones
