Town of Auburn, Fond du Lac County; Section 29 Location: Located on Auburn – Ashford Drive East of Co. Hwy V. This Cemetery contains one stone with two names. It is at the top of a hill about ¼ mile east of Co. Hwy V, South of Campbellsport. Fire number 2055 is right next to this on the West side. The stone is next to a wire fence with debris piled up. You can just see the tip of the tombstone sticking up. Entry is to the East and requires a walk of only a few feet through weeds, twigs and logs. There may be other tombstones farther back but is so over grown it is hard to determine. There should be about seven graves here, (Re- Mr. John Terlinden of Campbellsport, Wisconsin)
