

**Special Village of Campbellsport Village Board Meeting - August 10, 2009**  
**Village Public Hearing which was held in the Campbellsport Village Council Room, 177 E. Main Street, Campbellsport**

Public Hearing was called to order by Pres. Pat Twohig at 6:00P.M.

Public Hearing notice was given to the Campbellsport News, National Exchange, Post Office, Library and posted at the Village Hall and in compliance with the open meeting law.

Pres. Twohig announced that the public hearing is required to inform property owners along the street improvement projects of the estimated projected costs they could incur. All property owners were hand delivered the notice and engineer worksheet with project costs as bid by the contractor.

Pres. Twohig introduced Scott Lamers from Lamers Construction. Mr. Lamers explained his company was contacted by Mueller Excavating to do the sewer lateral reconstruction by a process called pipe bursting. He had a sample which was pass around and Mr. Lamers explained his company has done hundreds of sewer laterals in communities. Some communities which can be contacted are Belgium, Fredonia, Little Chute, Kimberly and Kaukauna.

Mr. Lamers said this process is a positive way to reconstruct sewer lateral because they pull the liner from inside the basement to the main and if the old sewer lateral is missing a large portion of pipe this method creates a new pipe not like lining which was attach to the old pipe. The firm has been in business for 10 years. There is a fifty year warranty on the product. The process takes about 3 to 4 hours per property.

Property owners in attendance were able to ask questions and were answered by the representative, contractor and village board. The property owners present were in favor of the pipe bursting process and only questioned the time period for repayment back to the village. Clerk explained that the Village Board had acted on the Resolution at the July 30<sup>th</sup> meeting for pay back within 12 months and any remaining balance would then be put on the tax statement.

Renderman's questioned why they are responsible for the entire project on Grandview Ave. It was explained that when property is developed the developer is responsible for all costs and additional costs will be incurred(bypass lane etc.) because of requirement from Fond du Lac County because roadway is county owned. Sidewalk grade will be established and stormwater issues need to be addressed to satisfy drainage issues from their property into the village stormwater system.
