The second school in New Cassel, built in 1858

The first Public School in the town of Auburn and Ashford was on Forest Street in Block 15, Lot 6 of New Cassel Plat. It was constructed of logs, and had a puncheon plank floor.

The principal of this school for a number of years was Mr. Leonard Morrisey. The next building was constructed of stone with a V cross beam constructed roof. The well for water was dug just southwest of the building and the toilets were southeast of the building. The structure was hauled away for fill in the early 1920's, and today it is an empty lot with shrubs and
