

Village Board Publication – Campbellsport Village Board – November 28, 2006
Special Village Board Meeting which was held in the Campbellsport Village Council Room
177 E. Main Street, Campbellsport

Item#1 – Meeting called to order at 3:30 P.M. by Pres.Uelmen

Item#2 – Meeting notice was given to the Campbellsport News, National Exchange, Post Office, Library and posted at the Village Hall and in compliance with the open meeting law.

Item#3 – Roll Call: Tr.Boldt, Tr.Schwartz, Tr.Stoffel, Tr.Twohig, Pres. Uelmen

Others in attendance: Joanne Del Ponte, Kevin- Manager of Piggly Wiggly, Tom Janke, FDL Cty Hwy Dept.

Item#4 – On site discussion and review of extended bypass lane on West Side of Grandview Ave. in front of the cemetery property as well as extending curb, gutter, and possibility of moving the existing sidewalk.

Tom Janke of FDL County Hwy Dept. said he put in the County Budget money to finish the Grandview Ave. roadway with curb & gutter on West side running North to South from existing finished point. Installation of an inlet for stormsewer and tie into the existing pipe. Sidewalk easement has been obtained from the cemetery owners by FDL County, but moving sidewalk is not necessary, but suggested moving to West side of power poles if all parties agreed to move sidewalk. Project would be done by Fond du Lac County Hwy Dept. and sub out the curb & gutter portion and bill out to the Village their portion of project. . Cost share project with the Village at 50/50 ratio. Approx. figures were: Sidewalk \$3 LF= \$1050, curb & gutter - \$15 LF= \$4500, inlet = \$1500, pavement = \$5000, base coat= \$6000 - total Approx. cost of \$50,000.

The group then looked at the opposite side of street in front of the Piggly Wiggly(Crown Group) property. Curb & gutter could be extended from the corner of E.Sheboygan St. to the North and meet up with existing curb & gutter in front of current Aurora Clinic property. Sidewalk will be more of a challenge because of higher slopes. Sidewalk could be lined up with existing sidewalk in front of the Aurora Clinic property, but then an easement would need to be obtained from Piggly Wiggly owners or move into the ROW. A question came up about a retaining wall, but Tom Janke thought enough slope could be accomplished from the proposed sidewalk area to the existing parking lot.

Motion by Tr.Boldt, seconded by Tr.Stoffel to construct the West side of Grandview Ave. for approximately 330 ft. of new sidewalk, curb & gutter and install inlet for stormsewer and finish with pavement for bypass lane and cost share project with Fond du Lac County at a ratio of 50/50. Ayes-5, Noes-0

Motion by Tr.Boldt, seconded by Tr.Stoffel to take no action at this time on the East side of Grandview Ave. in front of the property currently known as the Piggly Wiggly, owned by the Crown Group of Illinois. Ayes-5, Noes- 0

Item#5 – Announcements - Clerk stated nomination papers are ready to be picked up by candidates, but papers cannot be circulated until Dec. 1 and also said overall taxes will go up \$.28 over last year.

Item#6 – **Motion** by Tr.Stoffel, seconded by Tr.Twohig to adjourn meeting at 4:07 P.M. Motion carried.
