## **The History of Campbellsport, by Roderick J. Reese**

Notes by Halbur: This folder appears to be the list of 156 topics, which Mr. Reese researched *or intended to research*, as well as a long list of people who provided information or who helped him do the research. Mr. Reese seems to have compiled all of the information he had accumulated relative to each topic he had researched. Unfortunately, of this effort, only these lists remain. The actual script of the compilations is not to be found. Regarding the list of contributors, there is no record as to what types of arrangements Mr. Reese had with these persons. In some instances, however, it is clear that there was some kind of contact between Mr. Reese and his contributors. For example, in at least one of the cemetery inscription records (Buffalo Unity), it states that Mr. Reese was the one who walked the cemetery copying inscriptions, while Jean Rentmeister did the typing.

There are both typed and hand-written lists in the original folder. There were also duplicate copies (carbon) of the typed lists. Mr Reese wrote "Not completed" in the margin next to a number of the items. In some instances, there was indeed information in his field notes, but in other instances there was not.
