

Village Board Publication – Campbellsport Village Board – October 3, 2006
Special Village Board Meeting which was held in the Campbellsport Village Council Room
177 E. Main Street, Campbellsport

Item#1 – Meeting called to order at 5:45 P.M. by Pres.Uelmen

Item#2 – Meeting notice was given to the Campbellsport News, National Exchange, Post Office, Library and posted at the Village Hall and in compliance with the open meeting law.

Item#3 – Roll Call: Tr.Boldt, Tr.Schwartz(5:46), Tr.Twohig, Tr.Stoffel, Tr.Volz Daniels(5:56), Tr.Yahr, Pres. Uelmen

Others in attendance: Stephanie Remillard, Joann Schrauth, Mark Gruber, Henry Straub

Item#4 – Mark Gruber explained that he noticed a lower pumpage capacity at Well #2 and contacted Jerry Groth of Strand Engineering about concern. After some checking and monitoring it was determined that there is probably a leak in the 6” column pipe in Well #2. Maintenance usually occurs every 8 years and we are past that time frame.

Three contractors were contacted to submit a price to repair the possible leak in the column pipe. A bid sheet showing the three bidders and price was presented: Municipal Well & Pump - \$3,872; Layne Northeast - \$4,900 and CTW Corporation- \$4,195. The Village has done work with all three firms and bids were reviewed with Jerry Groth of Strand and recommendation is to go with the apparent low bidder, Municipal Well & Pump for \$3,872

Tr.Twohig asked Mark Gruber the depth of well which is 370 ft. deep with a vertical turbine pump.

Motion by Tr.Twohig, seconded by Tr Yahr to contract with Municipal Well & Pump to repair and reinstall the well pump for cost of \$3,872 and Public Works Director to report back at Mon. Oct. 9th meeting any other necessary repairs and expenditures. Ayes- 7, Noes-0

50-70 ft of column pipe, couplings, wear rings on pump may need to be replaced per Mark Gruber.

Item#5 – Announcements - Tr.Twohig questioned about water and sewer connections on the 3 acre parcel currently owned by Theisen Family and inquiries by Mr. Rendermann. Water and Sewer can both be hooked up off of Hwy W per Pres.Uelmen after conversation with Mark Gruber-DPW in approximately the center of parcel.

Pres. Uelmen informed Board that 4-Seasons has obtained the final easement from St. Matthew’s Church with appropriate signatures from the Arch-Bishop Dolan.

Item#6 – **Motion** by Tr.Stoffel, seconded by Tr.Yahr to adjourn meeting at 6:02 P.M. Motion carried.
