Officers and Employees

Article I

School Crossing Guards

[Adopted by Ord. No. 254, 1997 (Sec. 2-62 of the 2008 Code)]

§ 102-1 School crossing guards.

The Police Department may appoint school crossing guards. Per Wis. Stats. § 349.215, the Police Department may provide adult school crossing guards for the protection of persons who are crossing a street in the vicinity of a school. The school crossing guards shall wear insignia or uniforms which designate them as school crossing guards and shall be equipped with signals or signs to direct traffic to stop at school crossings. Training of crossing guards will take place by the Police Department. Job specifics will be explained by adoption of a resolution.

Article II

Village Clerk-Treasurer

[Adopted by Ord. No. 63, 1947 (Ch. 2, Art. III, Division 2, of the 2008 Code)]

§ 102-2 Office created; appointment and term.

Pursuant to Charter Ord. No. 63, there is created the office of Village Clerk-Treasurer, who shall be appointed by the Village President and confirmed by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the Village Board. The Village Clerk-Treasurer shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal as provided by law. ~~Such term shall begin on May 1 of the year in which the appointment is made.~~

§ 102-3 Duties.

The Village Clerk-Treasurer shall perform the duties of the Clerk and Treasurer as set forth by Wis. Stats. 61.25 and 61.26 and such other duties as shall be required by the Village Board.

§ 102-4 Treasurer bond.

[Added 11-10-2008 by Ord. No. 315]

The Village Board of the Village of Campbellsport, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

- A. The Village of Campbellsport, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin shall be obligated to pay state and county taxes to the Fond du Lac County Treasurer, as provided for by Wisconsin Statutes.
- B. If the Village of Campbellsport Treasurer should default or fail to pay the taxes, then the Village of Campbellsport shall pay from the funds that shall be available to the Village of Campbellsport.
- C. By the adoption of this section, the Village of Campbellsport is exempting itself from posting the bond sufficient to cover all state and county taxes.

Article III, Village Assessor - REPEALED
