

## Chapter 55 Finance and Taxation

**[HISTORY: Adopted by the Village Board of the Village of Campbellsport by Ord. No. 67, 1947 (Ch. 2, Art. X, of the 2008 Code). Amendments noted where applicable.]**

**§ 55-1 Payment by check.**

Any and all accounts or demands against the Village, after same have been properly audited and allowed as provided by Wis. Stats. § 61.51, shall be paid by a check signed by the Village President and countersigned by the Village Clerk-Treasurer. The Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to send ACH payments to the Official Village Depository for payroll direct deposits and employee benefit payments.

**§ 55-2 Election to not give treasurer's bond.**

**[Added by Ord. No. 106, 1951]**

- A. The Village Board elects not to give the bond on the municipal treasurer provided for by Wis. Stats. § 70.67(1).
- B. Pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 70.67(2), the Village shall be obligated to pay, in the case the treasurer shall fail to do so, all state and county taxes, and also high school tuition and transportation, required by law to be paid by such treasurer.
