

Chapter 481

Weapons

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Village Board of the Village of Campbellsport by Ord. No. 117, 1956 (Ch. 20, Art. X, of the 2008 Code). Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 481-1 Discharge of weapons.

- A. No person shall, within the limits of the Village of Campbellsport, commit any of the following offenses, namely: discharge any pistol, gun, air rifle, air pistol, fireman or other weapon for the discharge of bullets, projectiles or pellets, whether the bullets, projectiles or pellets be propelled by an explosion of a gun powder or other explosion or by a spring, air pressure, or other mechanical device or whether the bullets, projectiles or pellets be propelled in any other manner within the Village limits unless granted a permit to do so by the police department. Permits shall be granted only to discharge any such weapons on land owned or leased by the applicant or some members of his/her family and then only when the circumstances are such that the discharge of such weapons on such land may be accomplished with safety. Permits may also be granted to persons 16 years of age or over to hunt on lands within the Village limits if such persons have the consent of the owner or tenants on the property on which such hunting will be done. It is provided, however, that nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent shooting on duly supervised rifle or pistol ranges, duly supervised shooting galleries and shooting of bows of less than 15 pounds pull, which activities are specifically hereby exempted from the restrictions of this section.
- B. Throwing or shooting of arrows, stones and other missiles prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any persons to discharge or throw by any means any dangerous missile, object, arrow, stone, snowball or other missile within the Village of Campbellsport; provided, however, upon written application to the Chief of Police and Village Board, a person may be granted permission by the Village Board to construct and maintain supervised archery ranges if, in the opinion of the Village Board, the construction or maintenance of such ranges will not endanger the public health and safety.
- C. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a penalty as provided in § 1-4.

§ 481-2 Concealment.

- A. The Village of Campbellsport adopts State Stats 941-23.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person other than law enforcement officers in the performance of their official duties, to use or shoot a slingshot, cross knuckle of lead, brass, or other metal, bowie knife, dirk or dagger, or any other similar dangerous weapon or deadly weapon within the corporate limits of the Village unless allowed by State Statute, and any person violating this subsection shall, upon conviction, be punished by a penalty as provided in § 1-4.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, approval, and publication. Adopted, recorded and approved this 2nd day of October 2019.
