



Regular Village Board Meeting Minutes
Monday, November 9, 2020 – 6 pm
Campbellsport Municipal Center
Community Room – 470 Grandview

- 1) The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by PR Krebs
- 2) Notice was posted at the Campbellsport News, Library, Municipal Center, and on the Village website.
- 3) Pledge of Allegiance
- 4) All Board members were present.
- 5) Motion by Hafemann, seconded by Jarmuz to approve the consent agenda with a spelling correction of Hafemann's name in the October 12th minutes. Motion carried, 6-0.
- 6) No items removed from consent agenda
- 7) No Licenses to approve.
- 8) Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Reseburg to approve invoices for payment in the amount of \$117,059.26. Motion carried, 6-0.
- 9) Chief Dornbrook reported that he would like to use the remainder of his budget to purchase soon-to-be required body cameras as well as 2-3 new rifles. The current rifles have carrying handles and optics which make them too large to fit properly in the vehicle. The new squad car is set up, and the Crown Vic is stripped and being stored. Dornbrook will investigate the best way to put it up for auction. He discussed the idea of a sidewalk along the North side of Columbus Parc Ct. to the concession area, so people do not cut across the parking lot. Tom Janke could prep the site and the county might be able to help with completing the sidewalk. The sidewalk extension is not grant eligible. An electrostatic sprayer was purchased, the disinfecting spray is safe on electronics and is environmentally friendly.
- 10) Motion by Reseburg, seconded by Jarmuz to approve purchase of body cameras. Motion carried, 6-0.
- 11) Tony "Doc" Leonard gave recommendations on recodification of Village Zoning and Building Ordinances. Most recommendations were clarifications and consolidations into a clearer order. Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Hafemann to approve Leonard's recommendations. Motion carried, 6-0.
- 12) Industrial Park Conceptual Plan Postpone.
- 13) Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Hafemann to approve Bowmar Appraisal contract renewal. Motion carried, 6-0.
- 14) Reviewed the 2021 Preliminary Budget. No new questions.
- 15) Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Jarmuz to approve the purchase of a new International Plow Truck for \$187,444.63. Build time is 75-90 days once order is placed. Motion carried 6-0.
- 16) Motion by Hafemann, seconded by Jarmuz to move into closed session – employee compensation. Motion carried 6-0



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- 17) Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Jarmuz to move into open session. Motion carried 6-0.
- 18) Motion by Wenzlaff, seconded by Zielieke to approve a \$2.00 per hour pay increase for Officer Caraballo. Motion carried 6-0.
- 19) Announcements:
- a) President Krebs announced that Trustee Zielieke is now Chair of the Public Works Committee, and Trustee Jarmuz is now the Chair of the Personnel Committee due to the resignation of Brandon Serwe.
