



Regular Village Board Meeting
Monday, March 11, 2019 – 6 pm
Campbellsport Municipal Center
Community Room – 470 Grandview Avenue

1 The meeting was called to order by PR Krebs at 6 pm. Gene Wenzlaff was excused.
2
3 The consent items were approved as presented with a correction to the minutes from 2/11/2019, line
4 35, the word “wire” should be “write” (Hafemann, Harvey). All were in favor, motion carried, 5-0.
5
6 The operator licenses for Robert Barkley and Shane Hale were approved (Serwe, Hafemann). Motion
7 carried, 5-0.
8
9 Invoices totaling \$97,407.90 were approved for payment as presented (Hafemann, Muraski). Motion
10 carried, 5-0.
11
12 The Police Department has been using door hangers to alert property owners of issues with snow and
13 ice on their sidewalks. A few sidewalks were cleared of snow and ice by Public Works and the home
14 owner was charged \$25. At this time, no one has been given a citation for not having their sidewalks
15 clear.

17 Brief discussion took place on HydroCorp and cross-connection inspections. Mark Gruber was asked to
18 find other companies that provide this service or contact other municipalities and see if they have an
19 employee certified in cross-connection training that would be willing to help out here. Gruber didn’t
20 provide any information, so PR Krebs contacted a local plumber who is willing to do cross-connection
21 inspections. More discussion needs to take place at the April regular meeting.

23 Dan Immel is researching Generac generators and should be able provide information for our April
24 meeting.

26 The 3rd blower at the WWTP is now showing signs that it is going out. We are unable to get parts for this
27 blower, so Strand Associates is suggesting replacement estimated at \$63,000. The cost is dependent on
28 what horsepower blower the DNR will allow. This will be discussed at the April meeting.

30 Gruber did not provide any information on Cintas First Aid and Safety cabinet items, so it will be
31 discussed at the April Meeting.

33 D&D Precision Cuts has been doing some work on brush cleanup in both parks. The Fire Department
34 does not want him doing any further work in Firemans Park due to the mess that he has made. They
35 have someone scheduled to take down the remaining trees and grind the stumps. They are concerned
36 about getting the park ready for the picnic in July. Brown can continue cleaning in Columbus Parc.
