- 1 The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by PR Krebs

- 3 Notice was posted at the Campbellsport News, Library, Municipal Center, and on the Village website.

- 5 All Board members were present
- 6
- 7 Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Reseburg to approve the consent agenda Motion carried, 7-0.
- 8
- 9 Motion by Hafemann, seconded by Wenzlaff to accept the operator license new and renewals for 2020-2021
- 10 as presented. Motion carried, 6-0. Serwe abstained
- 11
- 12 Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Jarmuz to accept the Class A and B Retailer Alcohol & Tobacco license
- 13 applications for 2020-2021 as presented. Motion carried, 6-0. Serwe abstained
- 14
- 15 Motion by Serwe, seconded by Zielieke to approve invoices for payment in the amount of \$37,326.12 Motion
- 16 carried, 6-0. Reseburg abstained
- 17
- 18 Chief Dornbrook reported that Officer Fritsch is still working under another officer and not on his own.
- 19 Dornbrook is still working on the ordinance revisions and needs to have a copy to General Code by June 20th
- 20 for review. They will then require final approval by the Village Board. Dornbrook will get an estimate on the
- 21 cost of changing the already recodified ordinances to bring to the board as well. There were 5 U. S. Flags and 1
- 22 Navy Flag stolen from Village residences on the evening of June 6th. Three have been found along Hwy. 67
- 23 between Hwy. 45 and Dundee stuck in the ground along the ditch. There is a \$700.00 reward being offered to
- 24 anyone with information on the thefts.

- 26 Motion by Hafemann, seconded by Wenzlaff to repeal Ordinance Chapter 2, Division 5 "Police & Fire
- 27 Commission". A future revision will replace this with a "Police Committee" Ordinance per state statute. Motion
- 28 carried, 7-0.

- 30 Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Serwe to allow the Police Dept. to use \$7,500.00 of the 2019 fund balance for
- 31 squad computers. Motion carried, 7-0.

- 33 Motion by Serwe, seconded by Jarmuz to Commit \$13,000.00 of the Police Dept. Capital Outlay to fund new
- 34 squad radios in the future. Motion carried, 7-0.

- 36 Motion by Zielieke, seconded by Wenzlaff to postpone Ordinance Chapter 11, Section 19 Outdoor Serving
- 37 Areas to be approved with all ordinance revisions rough drafts. Motion carried, 7-0.

- 39 Motion by Hafemann, seconded by Reseburg to approve Resolution 20-16 allowing certain streets in the
- 40 Village to be temporarily blocked for the Cougar 5K run/walk on July 25, 2020. Motion carried, 6-0. Serwe
