



Regular Village Board Meeting

- 1 The meeting was called to order at 6 pm by PR Krebs. All members were present.  
2  
3 The consent agenda was approved as presented (Hafemann, Wenzlaff). All were in favor, motion carried  
4 (7-0).  
5  
6 Police Chief Tom Dornbrook updated the board that he has one part-time officer out on medical leave  
7 (not work related). He also mentioned that one of his officers has mentioned he doesn't have time to  
8 work in the Village due to his full-time job and is considering resigning. The picnic and parade were quiet  
9 and there were no issues with drunkenness or disorderly conduct. The Lions Club donated \$1528 for  
10 tactical vests to be used during extreme emergency situations.  
11  
12 Kevin Harvey announced that CARES has had some inquiries on properties in the Village. The CARES group  
13 is also ready to start on a new project.  
14  
15 Motion made and seconded to approve the Operator Licenses for Denise Serwe, Casey Rinas, Candy Hahn,  
16 Angela Dechant, David Ruplinger, and Tim Lindsley (Serwe, Muraski). Motion carried 6-0, Abstain 1 –  
17 Harvey.  
18  
19 Motion made and seconded to get a National Exchange card for Fire Chief Craig Olson with a credit limit of  
20 \$5000 (Hafemann, Mowry). Motion carried 7-0.  
21  
22 Motion made and seconded to increase the National Exchange cards for Tom Dornbrook and Danielle  
23 Reseburg to have a credit limit of \$5000 each (Serwe, Wenzlaff). Motion carried 7-0.  
24  
25 Motion was made and seconded to repair pavement at the intersection of Martin and Railroad Streets and  
26 to have the blacktop area in front of the Police Squad Bay finished by Fond du Lac County for a total of  
27 \$11,600 (Wenzlaff, Hafemann). Motion carried 7-0.  
28  
29 Motion made and seconded to allow Public Works Direct Mark Gruber to close sections of trail in  
30 Columbus Park if deemed necessary for public safety due to the large amount of dying trees (Mowry,  
31 Serwe). Motion carried 7-0.  
32  
33 Motion made and seconded to approve payment of the bills amounting to \$73,794.57 (Mowry, Muraski).  
34 Motion carried 7-0. The bill for Good Fellows Rod & Gun Club should be held until an explanation is given  
35 to the Village Board.
