Regular Village Board Meeting
Monday, August 8, 2016 – 7 pm

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by PR Krebs. All members were present.

Error in 7-25-2016 Special Meeting Minutes “the walls will be liner panel, not drywall”.

Motion made by TR DelPonte to accept the consent agenda with the noted changes, seconded by TR Hafemann. Motion carried. (Aye-7, Nay-0)

TR Hafemann made the motion to approve the invoices for payment as presented in the total amount of \$139,412.62. The motion was seconded by TR DelPonte and carried. (Aye-7, Nay-0)

Joan Rosenthal introduced herself and explained why she is running for the office of Fond du Lac County Treasurer. She gave information on her background and experience.

Discussion took place on putting a referendum question on the November 2016 ballot to increase the levy limit to pay for the wages and benefits of hiring an administrator. A citizen voiced concerns about the estimated amount for hiring an administrator. Board members commented that we need to be truthful to the residents. No action taken.

Mark Gruber, Director of Public Works, recommended to the Village Board of Trustees that a decision on the cross-connection re-inspections wait until HydroCorp is further along in the program. Topic tabled for future evaluation.

Gruber and Bill Hess, Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator, stated that the decision to hire a service to inspect and calibrate flow meters was made for 2016 in the amount of \$300.00.

Motion to adjourn at 8:32 pm made by TR Schickert and carried by voice vote.
