



Regular Village Board Meeting Minutes
Monday, September 13, 2021 – 6 pm
Campbellsport Municipal Center
Community Room – 470 Grandview

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by PR Krebs.

Notice was posted at the National Exchange Bank, Campbellsport Library, Municipal Center, Village website.

Pledge of Allegiance

Board members present, Krebs, Hafemann, Jarmuz, Reseburg, Wenzlaff, Zielieke.

Motion by Zielieke, Jarmuz to approve the consent agenda, Motion carried, 6-0.

Motion by Hafemann, Jarmuz to approve 1 operator license application, Motion carried, 6-0.

Motion by Hafemann, Wenzlaff to approve payment of invoices totaling \$279,291.34. Motion carried, 6-0.

Chief Dornbrook reported that the new approved ordinance changes will go into effect on 9/14/21 and the PD will have to update all citations to reflect new ordinance numbers. The PD is in the final stages of switching to the new CAD record management system. FDLac County IS dept. will take over the PD e-mails and backups for added security. They may also take over the village departments e-mail and backups. We may have to upgrade our phone system though. A reward is being offered for a vehicle vandalism. There have been major traffic issues at the High School with children crossing and vehicles not obeying traffic laws.

Residents at 422 E Main St. will be moving as they cannot finance repairs of their home.

Motion by Jarmuz, Hafemann to approve additional lighting estimate of \$4,690.00 for Columbus Parc, Motion carried, 6-0

Motion by Zielieke, Jarmuz to authorize the Village attorney to proceed with warrant for village to get code violation cleaned up at 124 E. Sheboygan St.

Motion by Zielieke, Wenzlaff to approve FDLac County plan and funding for Columbus Parc trail renovations in 2022. Motion carried, 6-0

Motion by Reseburg, Hafemann, to designate ARPA funds to the Barton Rd. Lift station project. MSA will begin engineering for the project. Motion carried, 6-0

Motion by Zielieke, Jarmuz to adopt Ordinance 2021-2, a revision and codification of the ordinances of the Village of Campbellsport, WI Motion carried 6-0

Motion by Jarmuz, Hafemann to not retain a company to archive our social media at this time, Motion carried 6-0



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Motion by Hafemann, Jarmuz to approve a proclamation to honor Patricia Hayes for her years of medical service to the Village of Campbellsport, Motion carried, 6-0.

Motion by Zielieke, Jarmuz to request an RFP for audit services with a 3-year contract, Motion carried, 6-0.

The lighted Village Hall sign has been repaired by RAW Power with the assistance of President Krebs. There is a 5-year warranty on the work.

Street Project updates: All the water mains are installed and have passed BAC-T tests. There are some lateral bursts that need to be done yet on Fond du Lac Ave. and the west end of E Main St., a few hydrants, intersection tie ins, curb, gutter, and sidewalks will be done in the next few weeks. There is storm sewer to be finished from Elm to FDLac Ave. They are hoping to start some paving by the end of September.

The county crew is doing undercutting on Hwy. Y and fixing the slope on the north side of the road.

Luke Koch will donate his labor to redo the sidewalk at wayside/memorial park so that the color and stamping matches.

Volz Concrete will be replacing paths from the Columbus Parc parking lot to the trails.

Trash collection in the village continues to have problems with missed pickups. The compost dumpsters take weeks to be replaced. We may just get them from Guelig as they respond much quicker.

Announcements: There will be a finance committee meeting on September 22nd to begin the budget process.
