Special Village Board Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 pm by PR Krebs. Mark Gruber was in attendance. Kevin Harvey was excused from the meeting.

**TR Schickert made the motion to go into Closed Session at 6:03 pm pursuant to State Statute 19.85 (1) (f) Considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons except where par. (b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations, seconded by TR Hafemann. Motion carried. (Ayes-6, Nays-0)**

**TR Hafemann made the motion to return to Open Session at 7:03 pm, seconded by TR Serwe. Motion carried. (Ayes-6, Nays-0)**

PR Krebs stated that a Village employee will be terminated on August 16, 2016, at 7 am for recurring absenteeism.

- Gruber stated he received a report back on the water tower and there is sediment in a detention tank that needs to be removed.
- Gruber stated that individuals interested in purchasing the St Francis Center have asked if they could park a storage trailer on the property until they build a garage. There is no ordinance preventing a trailer to be parked on the property for storage.
- There has been a complaint made to the Village about a property owned by Wayne Bauman on Washington Street. Bauman is cementing an area for vehicle parking and the complainant feels this will lower the value of homes in the area.
- CAA members have voiced concern about white clover. Gruber explained that Public Works will be spraying the clover in Fall.
- Dolores Sklenner's daughter, Dawn, has been in contact with Gruber about donating a bench to the Village in remembrance of her mother.
- There is a bench in front of the former Village Hall location at 177 East Main Street that will be brought to the Municipal Center. Tim Phillips will also be removing lettering off the former Village Hall building.
