Motion to move into Closed Session at 6:06 pm pursuant to §19.85 (1) (c) Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility made by TR Hafemann, seconded by TR Mowry. Motion carried. (Aye-7, Nay-0)

Motion to return to Open Session at 7:58 pm made by TR Hafemann, seconded by TR Harvey. Motion carried. (Aye-7, Nay-0)

TR Muraski made the motion to hire Holly Gerard as WWTP operator immediately at the wage discussed, seconded by TR Serwe. Motion carried. (Aye-7, Nay-0) She will be hired to work as many hours (up to a maximum of 40) as she can fit into her schedule and the position could possibly lead into permanent full-time. Holly will have a background check and drug/alcohol screening and Employee Manual policies will be followed should any issues be found.
