

# Village of Campbellsport

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WATER & SEWER COMMITTEE MEETING

05/12/2014, 6 pm

Village Council Room - 177 East Main Street

**Members present:** Chair Pat Twohig, Joanne DelPonte, Dave Schellhaass

**Others in Attendance:** Public Works Director Mark Gruber, Clerk-Treasurer Becky Tellier, WWTP Bill Hess, Janet Hafemann, John & Jean Janz

Chair Twohig called the meeting to order at 6 pm.

The minutes from 4/14/14 were approved as presented by DelPonte and seconded by Schellhaass.

John & Jean Janz explained to the committee their research regarding the amount of carwash water that never reaches the sewer. Water leaves the carwash bay by being evaporated, airborne water particles, and run-off at bay exit. At Firebug Car Wash, some dirty water does go down the sewer but sand is trapped in a holding tank under the bay. Purified water is used for the spot-free rinse – if it wasn't purified, there would be spots left on the vehicle.

Towards the end of 2013, the Seideman's could see water by their curb stop. There was a crack in the copper pipe under the flare-fitting. The charge for the repairs done by Mueller Excavating came to \$1495. A motion was made by Schellhaass, seconded by DelPonte to send the bill for the full amount and allow 1-year for Seideman's to pay.

Director of Public Works, Mark Gruber, was called by Dave Krebs (128 Killdeer Avenue) for sounds of water running but no meter movement. Our policy has been if the leak is between the curb stop and house, it is the property owner's responsibility to pay for repairs. DelPonte made the motion and Schellhaass seconded, to hold off on a decision as to who's responsible for payment until the actual leak location is detected.

Adjournment took place at 6:54 pm by a voice vote.
